Overview:

- **HSS, NIOSH, Union partnership**
- **Focus on model for safety training workshops nationwide**
- **Enhancements to the safety of site operations through training**



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Goals:

- Strengthen the safety of ORO/YSO site operations
- Enhance quality/efficiency of ORO/YSO safety training
- Reduce redundancy/duplication of safety training programs



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Methodology:

- Collaborative pre-planning
- Data assessment (ORPS, CAIRS)
- Facilitated 1 ½ day workshop format
- Opening presentations
- Diverse break-out groups
(union/worker trainers, Federal,
contractor staff)
- Final day report-outs



ORO/YSO Safety Training Workshop



Results:

- **Communications**
 - Standard training records system
 - Communicating training issues
 - Sharing training schedules, lessons
- **Training Quality/Portability**
 - Standard acceptance criteria
 - Standard course evaluation criteria
 - Instructor qualification
 - ARRA – training for new workers



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Recommendations:

- Increase membership of ORO/YSO Safety Training Working Group
- Implement training results database
- Establish POC list
- Develop standard criteria for course and instructor evaluation



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Path Forward:

- On-going planning for SRS safety training workshop
- 2 additional sites during FY 10
- Evaluate cumulative data from all safety training workshops
- Recommend common safety training initiatives across DOE
