# Contract

- Contract Start: June 6, 2004
  - 3 Year Base – ended September 2006
  - 7 Option Years – 3 option periods exercised
  - Contract Type – Performance Based Cost-Reimbursement
- Prime Contractor - Computer Sciences Corporation (CSC)
  - HPM Corporation – Imbedded Subcontractor
- Annual Budget \$13.5M (FY 07)



# Contract Features

- Unique in U. S. Department of Energy (DOE) – Occupational Health Prime Contractor to the DOE, Richland Operations Office (RL)
  - Benefits
    - Viewed as an “Honest Broker” by both labor and management
    - Consistency in medical approach

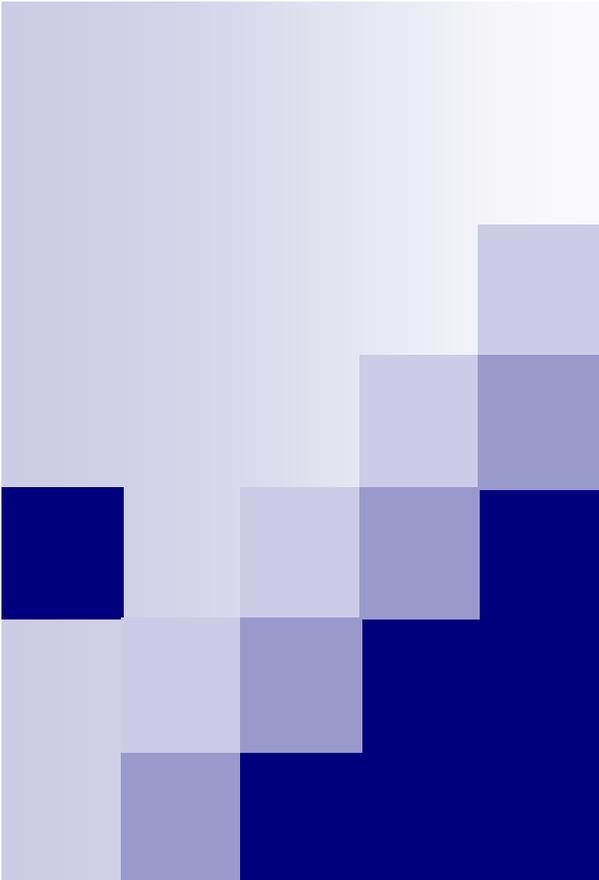
# Facilities

  - Random Drug/Alcohol Testing Site

    - 1 nurse

    - 2 receptionists



# Considerations

- Employee Job Task Analysis – Site wide system to access hazard information and use for medical decision making (10 CFR 851)
- Behavioral Health Services - Employee Assistance Counseling, psychological/substance abuse assessment, outreach and crisis intervention, Human Reliability Psychological Evaluations (10 CFR 851)
- Health Productivity and Management – comprehensive wellness, health education and industrial rehabilitation program (10 CFR 851)
