

Directions to the NTC Campus

The National Training Center (NTC) is located on Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB) in southeastern Albuquerque. If you are driving, you should enter the base through either the Gibson or Wyoming gate.

- You can access the Wyoming gate by proceeding south from I-40 on Wyoming Boulevard, or
- You can access the Gibson gate by proceeding east from I-25 on Gibson Boulevard.

From the Gibson gate:

1. Continue driving east on Gibson until the first stoplight (Pennsylvania).
2. Turn right onto Pennsylvania and proceed as described in #3 below.

From the Wyoming gate:

1. Continue driving south on Wyoming until it ends at Pennsylvania.
2. Turn left on Pennsylvania.
3. Stay on Pennsylvania past the golf course and riding stables, until you reach the foothills.
4. At the foot of the hills, the road curves sharply left and becomes Barrack Road. Stay on Barrack Road.
5. Park in the second paved parking lot on the right. This parking lot has a "Visitor's Parking" sign. A map of the campus can be found on the walkway above the parking lot.

Visitors to Kirtland Air Force Base

If you have a standard Department of Energy (DOE) badge, you should be able to access the base by presenting your badge to the guard at any Kirtland Air Force Base gate. Vehicle passes are not required.

The guard may verify the following information from visitors:

- Current registration
- Proof of insurance
- Driver's license
- Rental agreement (if applicable)
